RADIO MASTS REGULATION ACT 1988

RADIO MASTS REGULATION ACT (MODIFICATION) ORDER 1991

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 3(1) and (3) of the Radio Masts Regulation Act 1988 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made:-


Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Radio Masts Regulation Act (Modification) Order 1991 and shall come into operation on the 1st November 1991.

Modification of s.3(2) of the Act

2. In section 3(2) of the Radio Masts Regulation Act 1988, for the word "principally" there shall be substituted "exclusively".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order)

This Order modifies the exemption of domestic masts and antennae from the licensing regime under the Act. In future such masts and antennae will only be exempt if they are used "exclusively" for domestic purposes. At present they are exempt if used "principally" for domestic purposes.
